Rules and Regulations for Kids-Q

1. There will be two (2) age group distinctions: **10 and under** & **11 -15**
2. **PREPARATION, COOKING AND PRESENTATION:** Kids-Q contestants must do the preparation, cooking and presentation. If they are unable to do all of this on their own; they are too young to cook. Kids-Q contestants are not permitted to help with fires, slicing or anything considered dangerous.
3. Handicapped children need not be eliminated from competition, but will be allowed to do as much as they are able with some help from an assigned person.
4. All children will cook in a designated cooking area on grills provided by the Plant City Pig Jam. (Families with more than one child participating can cook on the same grill if they choose.)
5. A parent/guardian must be present with the child during the entire cooking process. **CONTESTANTS ARE TO DO ALL THE COOKING.**
6. Entries will be submitted in numbered containers provided by the Plant City Pig Jam.
7. Garnish of any kind is permitted, i.e. lettuce, parsley, tomato, carrot, flowers.
8. Slicing meat for presentation is not required. Judges will be equipped to slice the presentation at the judging table.
9. Judging will be based on **APPEARANCE, TENDERNESS/TEXTURE and TASTE.**
10. Judging ranges are from nine (9) being the highest to one (1) being the lowest.

DEFINITION OF FOOD CATEGORIES

Chicken Breast: The breast of a chicken

Anything Goes: Fix your favorite dish. It need not be BBQ. Anything goes, but it must be cooked directly on the grill (not in a pot).

KIDS-Q COOKS MEETING

8am on Saturday, November 19

(It is **mandatory** that you attend this meeting to pick up food containers.)

MEAT INSPECTION

Meat will be inspected upon arrival, and must be uncooked and kept below 40 degrees. A cooler with ice is ok.

SUPPLIES

A grill will be provided to each Kids-Q contestant. Contestant must supply all of his/her own meat, cooking ingredients, cooking utensils, etc., and must cook on the grill provided.

ENTRY FORM

Entry fees are required with submission of entry form.
