Plant City Pig Jam Food Categories/Prizes

Definition of Food Categories

**YOU MUST ENTER ALL FOUR FOOD CATEGORIES TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR THE
GRAND CHAMPIONSHIP**

BBQ Ribs

The portion of the hog that contains the ribs, no “country style.”

BBQ Pork

Pork shoulder or Boston butt. It can be presented as sliced, chopped, shredded, or pulled.

Beef Brisket

The breast or lower chest of a beef animal, “whole (packer trimmed), “point” or “flat” are acceptable cuts. NO CORNED BEEF.

Chicken

Any portion of the whole chicken that is grilled or barbecued.

** All meat must comply with ALL KCBS Rules.

Rules and Regulations

Upon arrival, check in at the Registration area for your space assignment and hospitality package. You may set up any time after 10 am on Thursday, November 18th and you may not tear down prior to the awards ceremony at 5 pm on Saturday, November 20th

COOKS MEETINGS

6 pm Friday, November 19, 2010

(It is mandatory that you attend this meeting to pick up food containers.)

MEAT INSPECTION

Meat will be inspected upon arrival. Uncooked meat must be kept below 40 degrees. A cooler with ice is okay. Cooked food must be kept above 140 degrees. You will be checked periodically to see if you are in compliance.

TEAM NAME

Each team must submit an official team name that cannot be changed later. In case of duplicate names, the earliest postmarked shall prevail. A cooking team shall consist of a chief cook and as many assistants as desired as long as they will fit inside your cooking area. The committee expects that good taste will be used-not only in your cooking, but in your area as well. We want each team to have a good time, and we want t a good family atmosphere for those who attend. **THE CHIEF COOK WILL BE HELD RESPONSIBLE FOR THE CONDUCT OF HIS TEAM AND GUESTS.**

SUPPLIES

Each contestant shall supply all of his own meat, cooking ingredients, individual cooking devices, utensils, preparation tables, etc. The only thing provided for you is a regulation cooking area, electricity (\$25 fee applies) and water (on site, but not to every space). All contestants must adhere to all electrical, fire and other codes set forth by the committee.

PIG BUCKS

All Contestants and Vendors selling BBQ or any other item at the Plant City Pig Jam will use Pig Bucks only. No cash sales will be permitted. The contestant/vendor retains 80%, and the contest receives 20% for charities

ENTRY FORM

Entry fees are required with submission of entry form. Due to limited space, the size of each cooking area will be 20 x 15. Contestants must stay within the boundaries of their allocated area. (For example do not erect a 20' x 15' tent if the tent ropes would not be within your area.) Fire Marshall will have strict control.

RV PARKING &ELECTRIC

The RV spaces are towards the back of the event and are a bigger than the regular cook sites. We can only park 18 RVs within the competition area (first signed up, first served), all others and nonparticipating RV's will be located elsewhere. RV's will run on their own generator/power – there will be no additional free hook ups. We will have a generator available to plug into at a fee of \$100. This fee will be collected on site once a connection has been made.

OTHER RULES AND REGULATIONS

Please note – golf carts are NOT permissible on the property.

In addition to the rules and regulation listed above, the Kansas City Barbeque Society's Rules and Regulations will apply.
